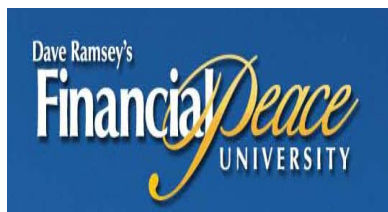

Dr. Clyde Medder.  
Dr Medder is the  
Executive Vice-  
President of the  
International Mission  
Board. He was born  
in Arkadelphia,  
Arkansas. Later he

received his Master of Divinity degree  
from Midwestern Baptist Theological  
Seminary, Kansas City, Mo. (Where  
our Builders for Christ will be this  
summer!) Clyde began serving as a  
career missionary in 1974. He served  
in Indonesia, India, Pakistan, and  
Bangladesh. He also served as on-field  
leadership for all countries of southeast  
Asia, South Asia, and Central Asia  
with a total 27 years on the foreign  
mission field. He resigned from  
missionary service to join IMB home  
office staff in 2001. In 2003 he  
became the Executive Vice-President.  
He and his wife Elaine have two grown  
children and four grandchildren.



Speaking during the Wednesday night service is Dr. Russ Moore. Dr. Russell D. Moore is the

Senior Vice-President and Dean of the School of Theology at The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. The grandson of a Mississippi Baptist preacher, Dr. Moore is also a preaching pastor at Highview Baptist Church in Louisville, where he ministers weekly. He speaks and writes frequently on issues ranging from the Kingdom of God to a theology of country music. Dr. Moore's latest book is *Adopted for Life: The Priority of Adoption for Christian Families and Churches*. He and his wife Maria have four sons: Benjamin, Timothy, Samuel, and Jonah.
