During the past 3 ArMOM Clinics, an average of 760 volunteers have seen an average of 1600 patients for almost 2900 extractions and 1400 fillings each year! In addition to dentists, dental assistants, and hygienists, we need over 300 support volunteers such as patient escorts, equipment loaders & un-loaders, break room servers, and many other positions. Set-up is on Thursday, May 20, with treatment days Friday, May 21 and Saturday, May 22. Tear down/pack-up on Sunday morning, May 23.
