Dear Bro. Todd,

We were able to make her an appointment and in the advocacy room she asked if I could explain her pregnancy options. I educated her on the abortion process and answered all her questions. Then we began a conversation about the Lord. She assured me she was a Christian so we began to talk about God's will for the pregnancy. Before she left she made a follow-up ultrasound appointment and had even signed up for parenting classes. God had done a new work of grace in her heart and had replaced her fear with confidence.

That is just one of the many miracles we've seen God work at Hope. None of this would have been possible without your partnership. Together we shared the message of life and love in Jesus Christ throughout Southeast Arkansas and God has been faithful to bless the work of our hands.

We look forward expectantly to what God has in store for Hope in 2019. With His help, we plan to: purchase a new mobile unit to expand our reach in Central and Southeast Arkansas, hire additional medical staff, add STD testing to our list of services, kick off a marketing campaign to reach more abortion-minded men and women, and develop our men's ministry.

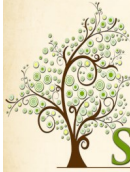
