# THE PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Watson Chapel Baptist,  
Yesterday in Deacons' Meeting, Dewayne Tanton shared how the Lord saved him over 60 years ago in a small town in Mississippi. He mentioned that Bro. Bill Barton was the pastor of the church. This brought to our minds that this is the month our youth travel to Home of Grace to minister to those going through their drug and alcohol recovery program. For 25 years the Watson Chapel Baptist youth choir and drama ministry have been traveling to Van Cleave, MS to minister to the Home of Grace. Here is a little history on the Home of Grace, *"In 1964, Rev. Bill Barton Sr., while pastoring a church in Pascagoula, Mississippi, took thirteen men to a Christian recovery program for alcoholics in Tallulah Falls, Georgia. He became convinced that God was calling him to establish a home for alcoholics in Mississippi. Out of obedience to what he believed to be God's will for his life, he returned home and asked eighteen men to be on the board of directors for the Home of Grace. E.H. Bacot soon donated ten acres of land, nestled on the banks of Bluff Creek, to the ministry. C.D. and Norris Faggard donated a small house trailer. In January 1965, even before there was electrical power, the first man entered the Home of Grace. Since that time, more than 35,000 men, women and children have been served through the ministries of the Home of Grace. With the support of many individuals and churches, the ministry has expanded to offer services for men, women and children hurting from addictive behaviors, domestic violence and homelessness. We thank God for the privilege of helping those in need--and for the faith that we will be able to serve many more even more effectively in years to come."* Home of Grace is faith-based and Christ-centered. For this reason they block off a week each July for our youth choir ministry to come and share about a great God who desires them to come to Him and have real life. Our kids will minister to the men and women through choir singing, solos, drama, band, and even some food and softball! This year, Bro. Garrett, Josh Aguilar, and Debra Burchfield get to follow up the youth program by sharing a brief message from God's Word. It is a powerful time as our church ministers to those struggling to find their way out of addiction. You can help by praying for someone throughout the week. A prayer partner system is in place where church members pray for someone specific who is on the trip throughout the week. If you do not have anyone, then pray anyway! Bang hard on the door of heaven that the Gospel would be received and embraced. Eternity is at stake for many souls... perhaps even in our group. Pray for Bro. Allan and Mrs. Rosie's health, endurance, and patience as they assume so much of the logistical burden for the mission team. Be in the evening service on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of July with some friends to receive a blessing as the youth lead in a homecoming concert. Every blessing, Bro. Todd
