THE PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Watson Chapel Baptist,

James 1:27 ESV **Religion that is pure and undefiled before God, the Father, is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world.**

It is great to be home but we sure did have a great week with the people of Casa Bernabe! That means "house of comfort." Casa Bernabe has been a place of comfort for hundreds of children since it opened its doors as an orphanage over thirty years ago. Many of these kids have been given a safe environment to receive an education, grow and function socially, receive medical attention, and most importantly, hear about the Savior, Jesus Christ. There are several staff members now teaching, caring and working at the orphanage who grew up at Casa Bernabe. Every day is a witness to the loving, miraculous provision of God and His gentle healing power in the lives of these children. For the Watson Chapel Baptist team, last week was a special time of ministering to children who live there and the missionaries who serve there. It was hard work! We sorted clothes' donations, cleared and cleaned up storage spaces, built a 16 X 16 woodshop extension, re-roofed old fiberglass roofing with metal, worked to correct an erosion issue at the back of the campus, harvested vegetables from the garden, weeded the garden and ran a dental clinic where hurting teeth were pulled and dirty teeth were cleaned. Additionally, our team members played with babies and kids and walked a lot of stairs. Casa Bernabe is situated on the side of a mountain! The Gospel was shared with many of those coming through the clinic and one man named Hugo gave his life to Christ! The orphanage has a school, homes, a medical clinic, an administration building with space for church services, a soccer field, and their very own tortilla shack where they make fresh tortillas nearly every day. Stay tuned for a full report one Sunday evening soon!

One great illustration connected to Christian service and giving is the comparison of the Sea of Galilee and the Dead Sea. The Sea of Galilee is not really a sea. It is a fresh water lake about thirteen miles long and seven miles wide. It is Israel's largest fresh water lake. It is home to twenty-four varieties of fish, the most famous being the St. Peter's Fish, or what we call Tilapia. The Sea of Galilee is supplied primarily by the Jordan River. The Sea is beautiful and teeming with life. The first-century historian, Flavius Josephus, was so impressed by the area that he wrote, "*One may call this place the ambition of Nature.*" Josephus also reported a thriving fishing industry at this time, with 230 boats regularly working in the lake. The Dead Sea, on the other hand, is a much different story. At 1,400 feet below sea level, its shores are the lowest dry land on earth. Its water is about ten times saltier than the Gulf of Mexico. Another consequence of the Dead Sea's saltiness is that nothing lives in the Dead Sea. Other than the high mineral content in the water which makes it medicinal for certain types of skin diseases, the Dead Sea is empty of life. It is sort of sad to drive for miles along the shores of this massive body of water and never see any signs of life. It earns its name, the Dead Sea.

Now consider that both bodies of water are fed by the same river, the Jordan river. The Jordan River flows into the Sea of Galilee and then through the Sea of Galilee. It continues south and flows into the Dead Sea. The same water, and yet one lake teems with life and the other is dead. Here's the difference. The Dead Sea is so far below sea level that it has no outlet streams. The water flows in, but it does not flow out. The Sea of Galilee takes water from the Jordan River, and then it gives water. The water simply passes through. As a result, the Sea of Galilee teems with life and beauty. The Dead Sea, on the other hand, only takes water. It gives nothing back, and as a result it sustains no life. Those two bodies of water bear witness to a truth of human life. It is in receiving and then giving back that life and blessing is received. Proverbs teaches this same principle.

Proverbs 11:24-25 ESV **One gives freely, yet grows all the richer; another withholds what he should give, and only suffers want. (25) Whoever brings blessing will be enriched, and one who waters will himself be watered.**

This church over the years has proven out this principle. So many here are so giving. I hope so long as the Lord leaves us in this earth for His glory, we continually look for ways to "water" others, trusting by faith the Lord will water us in the better spiritual ways! Much love, Bro. Todd
