THE PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Faith Family,

Well one of my kids told me yesterday that I had some explaining to do. I used the term LOCTITE in reference to God being the prime mover in salvation. We are in Ephesians 1 and the whole idea of predestination is all over Paul's non-stop sentence of praise which begins in verse 3 and runs to verse 14. I said something along these lines, "... *know this – God's predestinating purposes – adds LOCK-TIGHT red to salvation. If your remaining in Christ is up to you – or me – we will WRECK IT! If on the other hand, God is the PRIME-MOVER in salvation – it's a sure thing!*" That which God begins, He always finishes, see Phil. 1:6. So I was told no one knew what Loctite is. Loctite is a product you put on bolt threads. Once you tighten the bolt to the proper degree of tightness (called torque), the Loctite, in the absence of air and touching metal, forms a very strong bond. It basically adds holding power to a fastener. It makes a tight bolt remain tight. Now this sort of product comes in colors like yellow, blue, purple, and red. Each color corresponds the strength of the bond formed. For instance, blue Loctite is used in situations where you will need to remove bolts with normal hand tools for serving a thing like the scope on a rifle. In certain situations you need super strong grip, like in putting on wheel spacers on a vehicle. In that case, you would use red Loctite and red will not come off without heating up the bolt to 500 degrees! In other words, it is really on there! You would break the bolt before it gives in most cases. So, when I said God being the prime mover in salvation, you see why I said it's like Loctite red. He is holding us safe and secure!
